Engineer Nelson stated that we received the FEMA Hazard Mitigation funding for CD8 and presented two different bid packages for the CD8 project. The first will consist of replacing culverts and adding a Texas Crossing this summer. The second consists of clearing and brushing to possibly take place this winter. The board discussed the plans and decided on presenting it as one bid rather than two separate bids.

Manager Johnson made a **motion** to authorize advertising for bids. Manager Voll seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

The bid opening date was voted on and set for June 26th, 2025, at 9:30 a.m. with all yeas and no nays.
